# PHCCGA Youth Summer Plumbing Camp Agreement Form

We want to thank you for joining with us to make this PHCCGA Youth Plumbing Camp a success. Here are some important details you need to know.

## Guidelines

- This camp takes place Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm each day.
- This camp is open to any students from ages 13 to 17 years old and costs \$50 per student with a maximum of 16 students.
- Each day students will spend three hours learning hands on plumbing experience.
- Students may be dropped off at the camp or one guardian may stay with the students.
- Students must be picked up by the end time of 4:00 pm each day.

# Attire Requirements

- Students must have a pair of safety glasses and heat resistant gloves.
- Students must wear long pants and clothes toes shoes.
- All shirts must have at least 4-inch sleeves.
- Students are not allowed to wear jewelry or baggy clothes.

Under the supervision of a knowledgeable adult students will:

- Learn and describe the working of home plumbing systems.
- Learn plumbing health and safety precautions.
- Learn how to use important plumbers' tools.
- Replace a washer in a faucet.
- Clean out a sink or lavatory trap.
- Cut, thread, and connect 2 pieces of steel pipe.
- Solder copper tube connections using a gas torch.

Parent/Legal Guardian and Participant Commitment

- Questions and concerns should be clearly communicated.
- Disciplinary situations will result in dismissal. No refunds will be given for dismissal for behavioral situations.

## Code of Conduct

- Parents/Legal Guardians are responsible for their children's behavior to ensure they are following this code of conduct.
- Participants will respect the host facility.

The following will NOT be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal:

- Obscene Language or Actions
- Drugs, Alcohol, or Tobacco
- Weapons
- Roughhousing, Fighting or Aggressive Behavior
- Bullying
- Theft or Vandalism
- Threats
- Sexual Harassment or other Inappropriate Sexual Behavior
- Any Potential Life-Threatening Behavior

#### Illness

- In the event of an emergency, PHCCGA will attempt to contact parents/legal guardians immediately. If parents/legal guardians cannot be reached, information on the Registration form signed by the parents/legal guardians will be followed. If necessary, participants will be treated by emergency responders at parent/legal guardian's expense.
- Students must be symptom free including free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea for 24 hours before attending camp.
